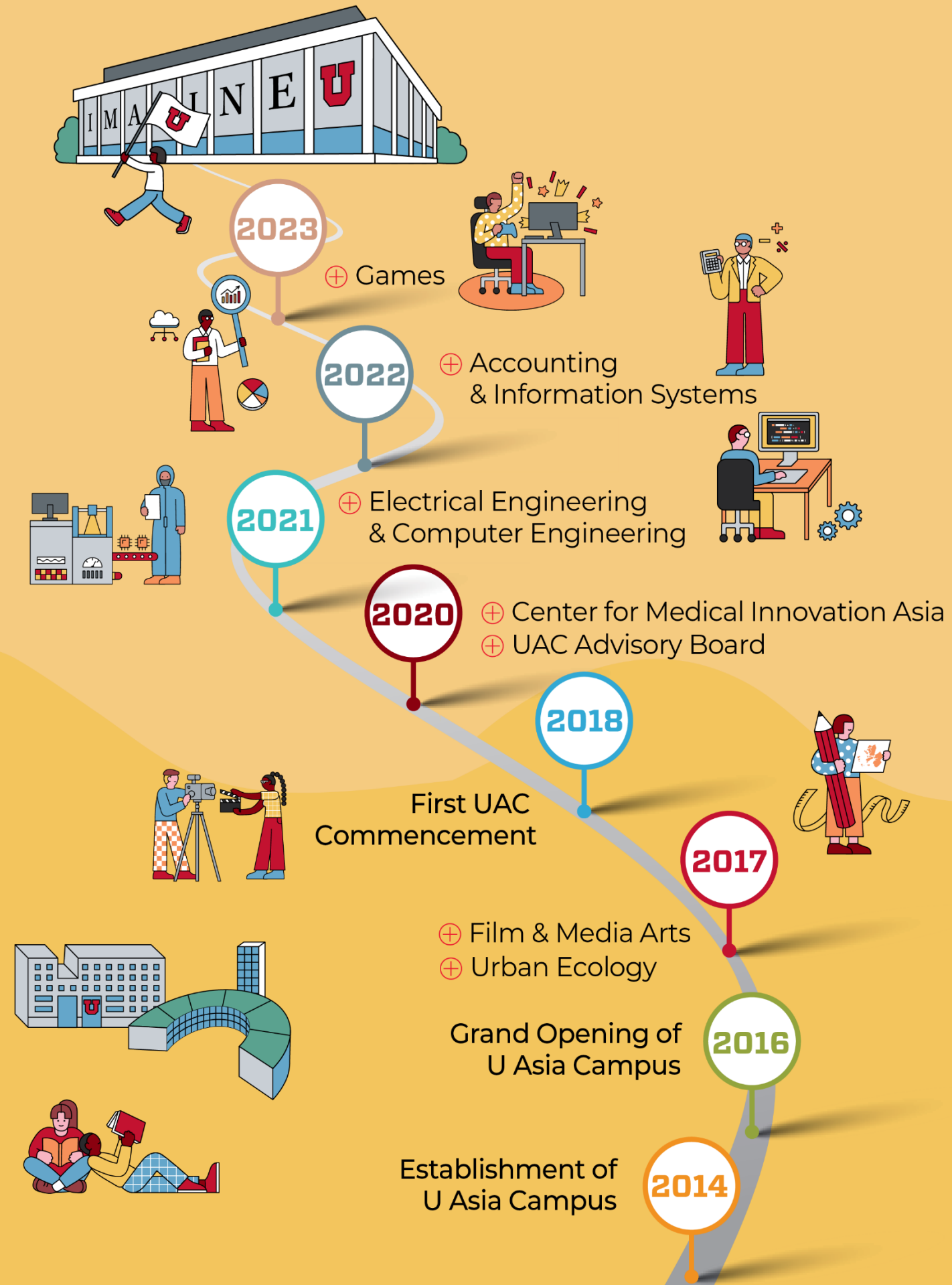

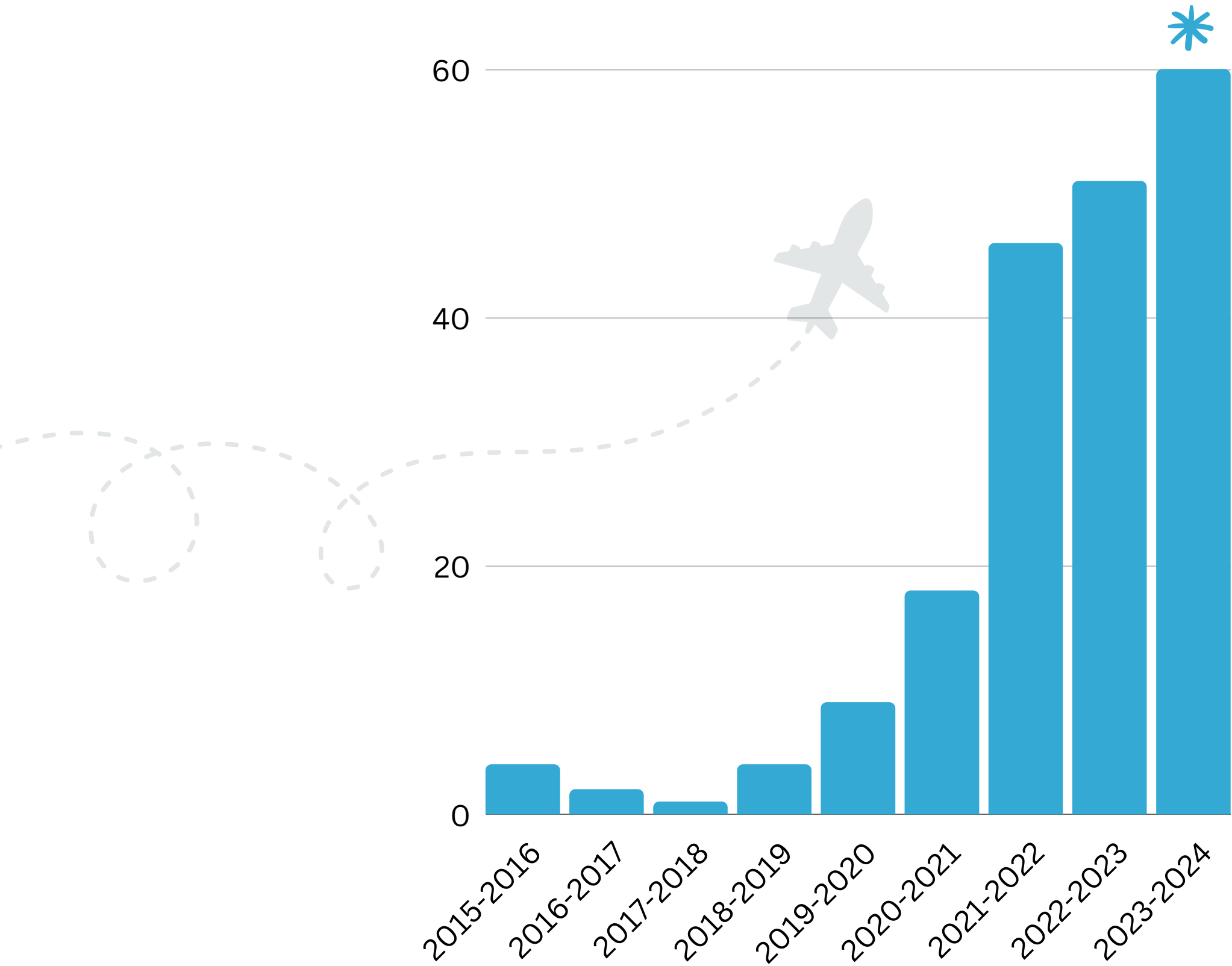

Areas of Study: urban ecology, planning, field studies, economics, law and social justice, green infrastructure, and sustainable development

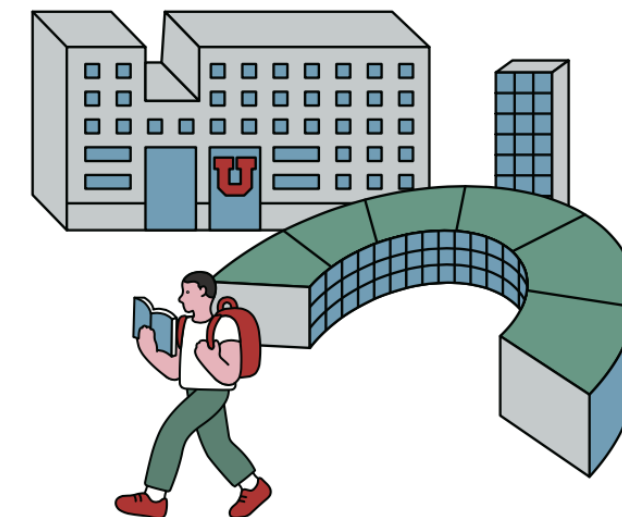
