**USCB to Host First Educators' Breakfast**

University of South Carolina Beaufort (USCB) has invited 100 public and private school administrators and counselors from four surrounding South Carolina counties and three in Georgia to a special Educators' Breakfast November 3.

Sponsored by USCB's Office of Student Development, the program will introduce administrators and counselors to new USCB student programs and services as well as provide information on the University's more stringent admission requirements. Also discussed will be factors that can make students more competitive for admission to the University.

High School administrators and counselors from Beaufort, Colleton, Jasper and Hampton counties as well as the three counties comprising the Savannah metropolitan area, Bryan, Chatham and Effingham counties along with 8<sup>th</sup> grade counselors from Beaufort County have been invited to attend.

Held from 7:30am to 10:30 am, the breakfast program will begin with an informal breakfast and professional networking time in the Hargray Building on the South Campus, followed by a welcome by USCB Chancellor Dr. Jane Upshaw and a presentation on the new degree programs that USCB has added in the last year. The educators will then have an opportunity to question key members of the USCB staff with regard to academic programs, campus lifestyle, admission requirements and financial aid. The program will conclude with a tour of the USCB South Campus facilities, including the new \$9.2 million library and student on-campus apartments.
