This Fulbright-Hays Group Projects Abroad Program (News Announcement) provides an opportunity for educators/students to be immersed in South Korean culture, language, and life on a 4-week educational trip to various institutional and historical South Korean sites in the Summer of 2024. Along with the 4 weeks abroad, all participants will be required to complete pre- and post- activities, which will coincide with aiding in a better understanding of how to educate students in curriculums related to South Korean culture. All travel, lodging, food, and cultural visits pertaining to the program activities in South Korea will be covered by the grant. *For educators/faculty, preference will be given to applicants with research, teaching, and educational background in Asian, International, and/or Multicultural Studies*.
