

USCTPENSION RECORDS

Basic Facts

- VETERANS could apply for an Invalid Pension based on a disability occurred in service.
- WIDOWS, PARENTS, SIBLINGS
 & MINOR CHILDREN who were dependent on the veteran could apply for a pension.
- NEW LAWS, enacted every decade or so, could expand eligibility for pensions.



Pensions can be between anywhere from 10 to 200 pages.

May contain interviews with the pensioner, their family, their neighbors, acquaintances, business associates, former owners & more.

Most interviews were taken between 1880 & 1910.

Held by the National Archives in Washington, DC.

My husband never owned and land or property; we didn't own any horses or cows; never owned more than a sow and a litter of pigs and a few hens. We didn't have to pax taxes, we didn't have any money; sometimes we'd have a little produce and take it to Bluffton to trade it off for stuff we needed, but we didn't get any money.






