What can I do with a degree in Public Health?

However, a variety of career paths for those holding a Bachelor's degree exists, including applying skills in schools, hospitals, health care facilities, work places, communities, government and non-profit organizations worldwide. Graduates of the B.S. in Public Health can also become health educators or community education specialists.
