#### Verification of 2022 Income Information for Parent Tax Filers

**Important Note:** The instructions below apply to each parent included in the household. Notify the financial aid office if the parents filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2022 or had a change in marital status after December 31, 2022.

**Instructions:** As part of federal student aid eligibility, parents will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In other words, if the parents filed separate 2022 IRS income tax returns, both must provide consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS.

If 2022 income tax return information for the parents was not available or could not be used, the parents should provide the institution with a 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript(s) or a signed copy of the 2022 income tax return and applicable schedules.

## A 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be obtained through:

- Get Transcript by Mail Go to <a href="www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a>. click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript by Mail." Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript." The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the online request.
- Get Transcript Online Go to <a href="www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a>. click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript Online." Sign in with an existing account or create a new account. Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript."
- Automated Telephone Request 1-800-908-9946. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.
- Paper Request Form IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form.

## Individuals Who Were Victims of IRS Tax-Related Identity Theft

An individual who was the victim of IRS tax-related identity theft must provide:

- A Tax Return Database View (TRDBV) transcript obtained from the IRS or, if unable to obtain a TRDBV, an
  equivalent document provided by the IRS or a copy of the signed 2022 income tax return and applicable schedules
  the individual filed with the IRS; and
- A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft.
