

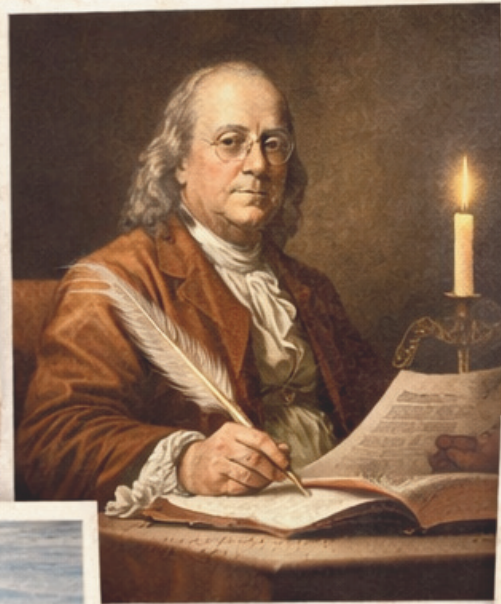

PARKING INFORMATION



Parking is complimentary for OLLI members who possess a valid parking decal. It's important to note that the **Bluffton campus** is particularly vigilant in issuing citations to those without decals to discourage public commuter parking. Additionally, OLLI members are permitted to park only in designated areas (Lots B) as indicated on the Bluffton campus map.

Reasons for Citations:

USCB OLLI Credit Card and Payment Policy



PURPOSE

To protect the financial security and personal information of our members, and to ensure efficient and accurate processing of payments and refunds, USCB OLLI has updated its credit card and payment procedures.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

For the safety and security of our members, USCB OLLI **no longer accepts credit card payments over the phone or in-person.** This policy reduces the risk of fraud and protects sensitive financial information. All credit card payments must be made through the secure USCB OLLI online member portal.

REQUIRED PAYMENT METHOD

Effective immediately, all credit card payments must be made using the member's online OLLI account/portal. Payments submitted through the portal ensure timely refunds on the original form of payment.

Check and/or Cash payments are still accepted in the mail or in-person.

Members who need help accessing their online account or completing a payment are encouraged to contact the USCB OLLI office at (843) 208-8247. Staff will gladly assist with navigating the portal with you but cannot accept or process credit card information.

This course examines the Declaration's language and arguments, asking what Jefferson meant by equality and liberty, how Enlightenment ideas shaped the text, and how convincing its case against King George III was.

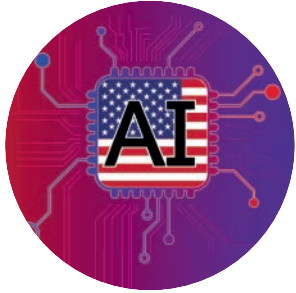

The world's population is aging at a faster rate than ever before and people are living longer. Every day until 2030, ten thousand baby boomers will turn 65 and seven out of ten people will require long-term care in their lifetime. (HIS320) THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION A WORLD WAR NO ONE KNOWS

American Exceptionalism rests on the belief that the colonies uniquely won independence from Britain largely on their own. In reality, the American Revolution was a minor theater in a global war, and victory depended heavily on military aid from European powers and Britain's entanglement with multiple rival nations.



RICHARD THOMAS

(HIS321) TEA AND TORTURE

Boston was neither the first nor the only site of a Tea Party; Charleston, Philadelphia, Annapolis, and Edenton, North Carolina also took part. Edenton, though small, sparked major outrage in Britain because the protest was led by women. British reprisals against rebels are also explored, including tarring and feathering—most famously inflicted on John Malcolm of Boston, though he was not the only victim.



LEE WIIWERDING

(HIS322) ORIGINS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION-3 PART SERIES

The American Revolution had many causes, which originated during the colonial period and took many forms. This course, which may be the first in a (long) series, will examine the development of colonial politics, the impact of colonial wars, and the effects of the Great Awakening in creating a nascent sense of American distinctiveness that led finally to the Revolution.



JOHN MCCARDELL

(HIS323) THE HEYWARD FAMILY OF SOUTH CAROLINA

The Heyward family traces its roots to about 1670, when Daniel Heyward settled in Charles Towne. His descendants, including Daniel Heyward and Thomas Heyward, established rice plantations in South Carolina's low country. Thomas Heyward Jr., a signer of the Declaration of Independence, played a significant role in the Revolutionary War, especially in the South.
