

WHAT IS DEGREEWORKS?

DegreeWorks is a web-based tool for you to monitor your academic progress toward degree completion by reviewing a degree audit. It allows you and your advisor to plan future coursework. DegreeWorks reorganizes your transcript chronologically and categorically, easily identifying courses you have completed and what courses you still need in order to fulfill your degree requirements. DegreeWorks also features a GPA calculator and a “What If?” audit to see how your classes will carry over to a new major, in case you are thinking about changing.
